General Statement On Appeals

An appeal is a request to have a decision of the Building Official reversed or modified in the event that the Building Official has made an error in the administration, interpretation, or enforcement of the adopted International Building and Fire Safety Code. Therefore, in order to file for an appeal, an applicant must allege that the Building Official has made an **error** in the administration, interpretation, or enforcement of the adopted code, must identify the specific provision or provisions of the code for which it is alleged that the Building Official's actions are inconsistent, and must provide a statement to support the allegation that the Building Official is in error.

1. What decision or order of the Building Official is the subject of this appeal?

2. Which provision or provisions of the adopted International Building and Fire Safety Code are alleged to be inconsistent with the decision or requirements of the ordinance administrator?
